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# **1** About TD Phone

## 1.1 Intended Use

TD Phone is a custom-built app for calling and messaging with just your eyes in a familiar way, even without previous eye-tracking experience. It is custom designed for people who cannot use their hands to interact with their mobile phone, with conditions such as ALS, CP, spinal cord injury, or traumatic brain injury. Anyone with previous experience with a mobile phone would find the experience familiar and easy to navigate.

TD Phone's design prioritizes familiarity while giving you flexible control over the conversation with the phrase and word prediction.

TD Phone gives people who use eye gaze a simple way to connect with anyone from anywhere.

## 2 **First Startup**

When TD Phone is launched for the first time, the following will be happening:

# **3 Connecting your Phone to TD Phone**

The Connection Guide that launches at first start of TD Phone will guide you to connect you phone to TD Phone.

To connect a second phone, or if you aborted the Connection Guide in the beginning, follow the instructions in *3.2 Connecting a Phone, page 9.* 

TD Phone works with both Android and iPhone.



Essential for Successful Connection:

- 1. Your mobile phone **must** always remain unlocked throughout the connection process.
- 2. Settings pages pictured in this guide **must** be visible on your mobile phone.

## 3.1 Prerequisites

Identify an assistant to keep the mobile phone unlocked and to make selections, if needed. Bluetooth must be enabled on your I-Series I-13 or I-16. For more information see, Bluetooth.

## 4.5 Track Status Box





The Track Status function checks if the user is correctly positioned in front of the eye tracker.

- The two (2) white dots The user's eyes and how they are positioned towards the screen. For optimal position, the white dots should be in the middle of the black area.
- The colorful bar on the right with the white arrow How far or close the user is positioned from the screen.
  - If the white arrow is in the middle of the green area of the bar, the user is at the optimal distance from the screen.
  - If the arrow is in the lower part of the bar move the user closer to the eye tracker.
  - If the arrow is in the upper part of the bar move the user further away from the eye tracker.

# 5 Using TD Phone

TD Phone is purpose-built for eye gaze. TD Phone's sole purpose is to empower people with communication and/or physical disabilities to stay in contact with anyone from anywhere using text messaging and phone calling. TD Phone uses your mobile phone's cellular connection. This means TD Phone will work where you are and makes your contacts and recent message history available when you need them.



Most of the functions/actions in TD Phone are also Touch and Mouse enabled, making it easier for a Caregiver or Assistant to help the user if needed. The Caregiver or Assistant can select an Action or change the settings for the user much easier.

## 5.1 Actions in the Off-Screen Menu



## 5.1.1 How do I Activate TD Switcher in TD Phone?

With TD Switcher, the user can switch between active software and start Tobii Dynavox Applications.

### 5.1.3 Pause in TD Phone

Using eye gaze is a repeated physical task, and the muscles in use around the eyes can become fatigued. Pausing gaze not only gives you time to look at the screen without interacting but also provides your eyes with time to rest.

## 5.1.5 Privacy Mode in TD Phone



In Privacy Mode, messages will be blurred, but you can still type a new message.

#### 5.1.5.1 How do I Activate Privacy Mode in TD Phone?

1. Fixate your gaze below the screen, in the middle of the eye tracker, or the area of the eye tracker. The Off-Screen Menu will become visible in the lower middle part of the screen.



(Privacy Mode) button.

All text messages will be blurred until deactivation.

5.1.5.2 How do I Deactivate Privacy Mode in TD Phone?

1. Fixate your gaze below the screen, in the middle of the eye tracker, or the area of the eye tracker. The Off-Screen Menu will become visible in the lower middle part of the screen.

All text messages will be visible again.

## 5.2 The Actions on the Dashboard

## 5.6 How does Mute/Unmute work in TD Phone?

For TD Phone on the TD I-Series the mute/unmute function effects only the microphone on device. When the microphone is muted the microphone will not pick up any sound from the environment. If the microphone is not muted, surrounding sounds will be picked up and the person on the other end of the phone line will hear it. By default the TD I-Series microphone is muted.





The text-to-speech spoken from TD Phone will not be affected.

# 5.7 How do I Quickly Change the Language for Voice and Keyboard in TD Phone?

### 6.3.1 How does the Calibration Process Work in TD Phone?

The calibration process works as follows:

The Test Calibration will be shown when a calibration starts, whether it is a Quick Calibration or a regular Calibration. This page offers you the chance to assess the quality of your calibration.

On the test calibration screen, there are circles with a small dot in the center. The purple dot shows where the user is looking. Fixating the gaze on one of the dots, it shows where the eye tracker registers the fixation in that dot and how small or large offset there is.

If the purple circle is within the dotted white circle, then the calibration is good enough for using TD Phone.



When the Calibrate button is selected, the first calibration screen will appear. It is a black screen, and in the center of the screen, there is one single purple dot with a black center.



Nothing will happen until the user fixates the gaze on the dot, the eye tracker will register the fixation, and the dot will blink once and disappear.

As long as the dot remains on the screen, the eye tracker has not registered the gaze data for that position.

A new screen will appear. It is a black screen, and in the four corners, an purple dot with the black center will be present.



Nothing will happen until the user fixates the gaze on one of the dots, the eye tracker will register the fixation on that dot, and the dot will blink once and disappear.



As long as the dot remains on the screen, the eye tracker has not registered the gaze data for that position.

When the user's have fixated the gaze upon all of the dots on the screen, and all of the dots have disappeared, the calibration process finishes and the test calibration screen will show up again.

Try out the calibration by looking at the circles on the screen. Close the test calibration screen or start a new calibration if needed.

## 8.5 How can I increase the volume of a phone call?

Mobile phones may have separate volume controls for internal speakers versus Bluetooth devices such as ear buds and the I-Series with TD Phone. You can adjust the mobile phone device volume only during an active phone call. Call someone or ask them to call you, then ask an assistant to adjust the volume using the volume buttons on your mobile phone.
